What Is a "Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System" (MS4)?

"Separate storm sewer system" includes ditches, curbs, gutters, storm sewers, and similar means of collecting or conveying runoff that do not connect with a wastewater collection system or treatment plant. And to be a "municipal separate storm sewer system" (MS4), the system must be owned or operated by a public agency-for example:

- City or town
- Municipal utility district, flood control district, or other special district
- County
